Last year was the same, fine weather on “our” Area 33 Sunday Lunch day and everyone takes to the roads!

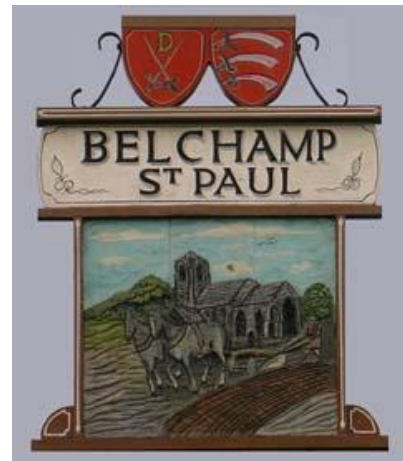
Despite The Half Moon’s address being Sudbury, Suffolk, the village green sign outside the pub clearly shows the Essex
